

## Candle


Model & Diagrams Jens Kober, 2011 (inspired by David Petty's Cactus) Use a 12x15cm paper for a 8cm high candle.




**1**. Start with the color of the flame down. The diagram uses a 4 by 5 rectangle, but other ratios will work as well. Fold vertically into 8th.




4. Fold and unfold two diagonals.




**2**. Add a pinch mark two units down on each side.




**3**. Fold the top down using the pinch marks as references.




**5**.Fold and unfold using the previous creases a references.




**6**. Add some more diagonal valley folds.




7. Pleat and unfold using the intersections of the creases as references. Pinch mark one unit at the bottom.




**8**. Fold the bottom behind (.5 units) and add mountain folds on top.




**9**. Collapse as indicated (redo the pleat from step 7 first). The model will not lay flat.




. Slide one end into the other to form a seven sided object.






**11**. Mountain fold the rim of the candle in half. Enlarged view.

. Rearrange the top of the flame as indicated.



. Fold the corners of the flame down in a circular fashion.



. Push in at the tip of the flame and bend it to one side.
