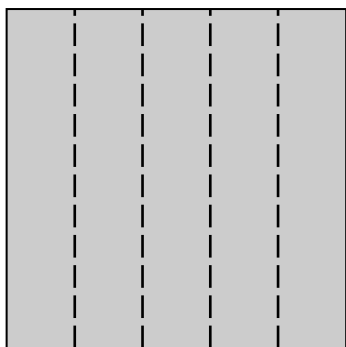
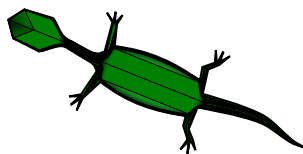


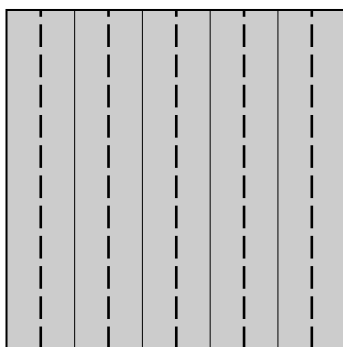
# Lizard

Model & Diagram Jens Kober, 2011&2017

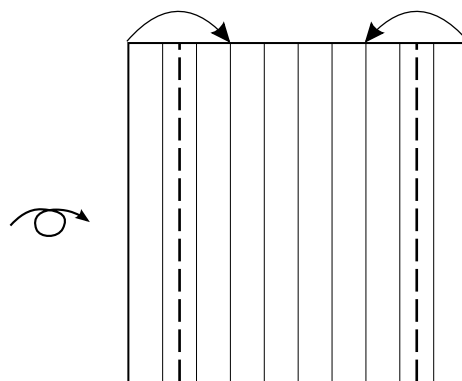
Use a 10x10cm paper for a 9.5cm long lizard.



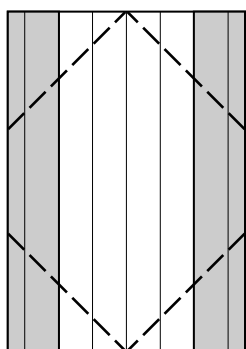
1. Start with the colored side up. Use your favorite method to divide the paper into 5th.



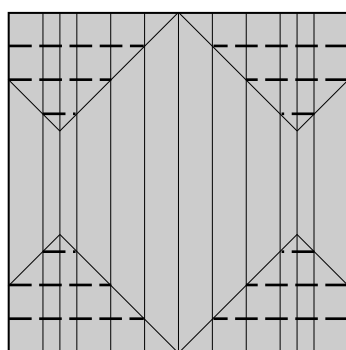
2. Divide into 10th. Turn over.



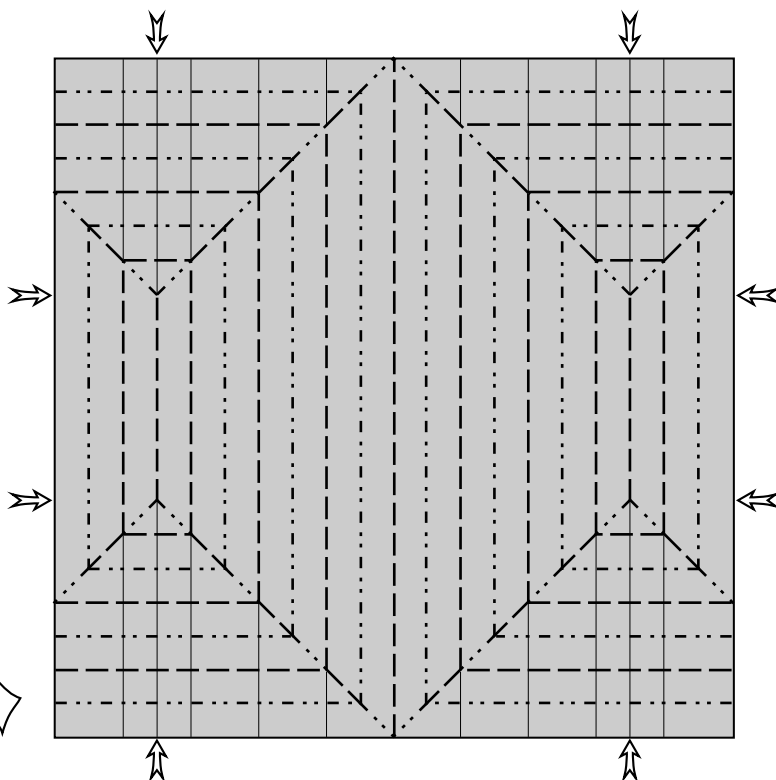
3. Fold both sides in.



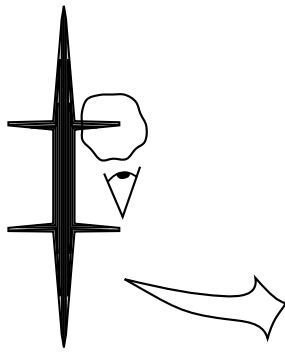
4. Fold and unfold four diagonals. Unfold the paper completely and turn it back over.



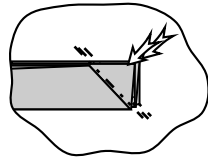
5. Add a few more valley folds. Enlarged view.



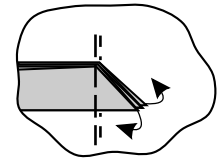
6. Add the indicated mountain folds and collapse (straightforward box pleating).



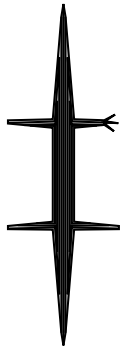
7. Enlarged view of the leg.



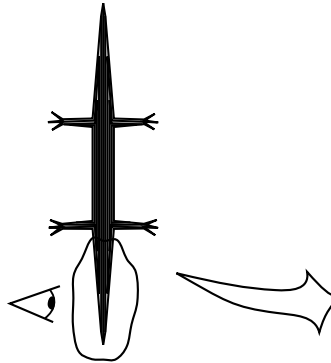
8. Inside reverse fold the toes.



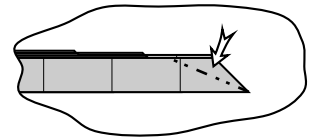
9. Slightly spread the toes.



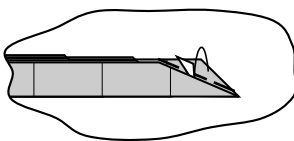
10. Repeat steps 8. and 9. on the other three legs.



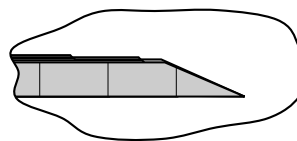
11. Enlarged view of the tail.



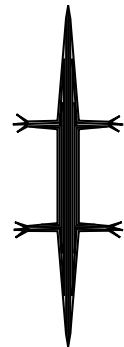
12. Closed sink the top layer of the tip with a 22.5° angle.



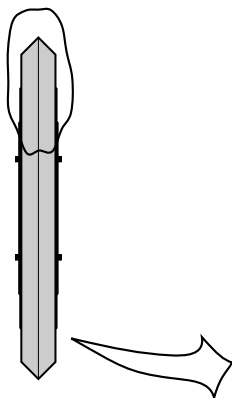
13. Fold the other corner over and put into the pocket.



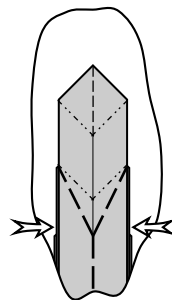
14. Back to original view.



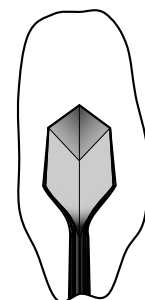
15. Unfold the central valley fold.



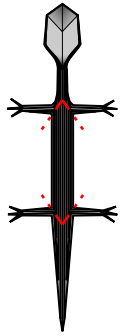
16. Enlarged view of the head.



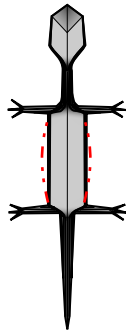
17. Push the top layer up from below and close the body again. The sides of the head will be perpendicular to the top. Fold the thin lines only lightly.



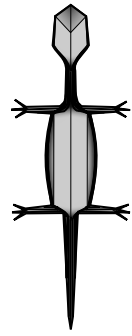
18. Completed head.



**19.** Push up the body similar to step 17.



**20.** Push up some more paper from the sides of the body.



**21.** Shape the neck, tail, and legs.
